Steps & Styling: Running step, ballroom waltz. Please also refer to English Country Dance Glossary.

<u>Meas</u>	<u>3/4 meter</u>	<u>Pattern</u>
4 meas		INTRODUCTION. No action.
A	1-4	Joining inside hands with ptr, waltz forward and back.
	5-8	Turn opposite R hand.
A	1-4	Turn ptr L hand.
	5-8	Half Ladies Chain. Stay in position with L hands joined and M's R hand on W's waist.
B	1-4	Slow chassé diagonally forward to R, then same to L, couples ending back to back.
	5-8	Dropping hands, all turn R into R-hand star across turning 3/4 to original place.
B	1-4	Dance back-to-back with opposite.
	5-8	Waltz with ptr in direction of dance to meet the next couple.
